





TNPSC BITS

- Supreme court of India held that stereotyping differently-abled persons in visual media and films perpetuate discrimination and creators ought to provide an accurate representation of disabilities rather than mocking or mythifying them.
- ❖ Azerbaijan Army and Kazakhstan is to take part in "Birlestik-2024" operational-tactical command-staff exercise held at Kazakhstan.
- **❖** The Construction of the 'world's largest Ramayan temple' began in Bihar's East Champaran district with an estimated cost of ₹500 crore.
 - o This will be taller than the 12th-century Angkor Wat temple complex in Cambodia.
- ❖ For the first time in history of the Indian civil service, an appeal by a senior Hyderabad-based Indian Revenue Service (IRS) officer to change her name and gender has been approved by the Union Finance Ministry.
 - He had requested a change of her name to M Anukathir Surya, and gender from female to male.

TAMIL NADU

Renewable energy production in Tamilnadu - 2024



❖ The renewable energy generation in the State has crossed the 50% mark with April witnessing the highest - 52%.





- * Renewable energy comprises wind, solar, hydro and cogeneration.
- ❖ The highest energy demand recorded being 20,830 megawatts (MW) on May 2 and highest consumption per day, 454 million units (MUs).
- ❖ The State electricity utility, had a total renewable energy generation in March, April, May and June at 24,530 Mus.
- ❖ The total generation of the state is 48,835 MUs, showing an average of 50% of clean energy composition.
- ❖ The State has, total generation power capacity of 34,700 MW.
- ❖ The renewable generation capacity was 18,300 MW including hydro power (2,300 MW), wind (8,750 MW), solar (6,550 MW) and cogeneration power (700 MW).
- ❖ The energy demand in the State breached the 20,500 MW touching 20,700 MW with the city recording 4,380 MW on April 30.
- ❖ In the same month the highest renewable energy generation of 6,900 MUs out of a total generation of 12,960 MUs was recorded.

Haj Committee




- ❖ The Ministry of Minority Affairs chosen as a nodal ministry instead of Ministry of External Affairs (MEA), for the Haj Committee.
- ❖ Earlier, the work related to the management of Haj pilgrimage, including the administration of the Haj Committee Act, 2002, and rules made thereunder was handled by the MEA.





- ❖ These rules may be called the Haj Committee (Amendment) Rules, 2024.
- ❖ In the Haj Committee Rules, 2002, for the words 'Ministry of External Affairs', the words 'Ministry of Minority Affairs' shall be substituted.

NIRMAN Portal



- ❖ The Union Minister for Coal and Mines has launched the NIRMAN Portal, part of Mission Karma yogi.
- ❖ NIRMAN stands for "Noble Initiative for Rewarding Mains Aspirants of National Civil Services Examination."
- ❖ The portal aims to support UPSC Preliminary exam qualifiers from SC, ST, female, or third gender candidates with an annual family income under Rs 8 lakh.
- ❖ Eligible candidates, permanent residents of Coal India Limited's 39 operational districts, will receive Rs 1 lakh.

CAMCOPTER S-100

❖ India is set to enhance its naval capabilities through a deal with Austrian company Schiebel for their Camcopter S-100 unmanned aerial system (UAS).





- ❖ The system can operate in various extreme climates and has a high endurance, making it ideal for the Indian Ocean Region.
- ❖ It requires the minimal space for launch and recovery, making it suitable for deployment from various naval vessels.

Colombo Security Conclave 2024

Colombo Security Conclave

- ▲ The 8th Deputy National Security Advisor level meeting of the Colombo Security Conclave was hosted virtually by Mauritius.
 - Bangladesh became the 5th full member country.
 - Seychelles participated as an observer country.
- The Colombo Security Conference is a regional security grouping.
 - It was formed in the year 2011.
 - Its founding members were India, Sri Lanka and Maldives.
 - Mauritius joined as the fourth member in the year 2022.
- ❖ Bangladesh has officially joined as the fifth member State of the Colombo Security Conclave (CSC).
- CSC is a grouping that includes India, Sri Lanka, Mauritius and the Maldives.






- ❖ The Colombo Security Conclave was established in 2020.
- ❖ India, Sri Lanka and the Maldives agreed to expand the scope of their trilateral meeting on maritime cooperation.
- ❖ Mauritius joined the conclave at the fifth meeting of the grouping in Male in March 2022.

MeDevIS Database

- ❖ WHO launched MeDevIS, an open-access hub providing information on 2301 types of medical devices.
- ❖ It aims to aid governments, regulators, and users in making informed decisions by offering a unified platform that simplifies the device naming and replaces traditional paper-based searches.
- ❖ Additionally, it covers 2301 types of medical devices used for various health issues.
- ❖ These include reproductive health, maternal and child health, diseases like cancer, heart problems, diabetes, and infectious diseases such as COVID-19.



SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY

Europe's Ariane 6 Rocket

- ❖ Europe's big new rocket, Ariane-6, has been launched on its maiden mission from Kourou, French Guyana.
- ❖ The Ariane 6 was designed to replace its predecessor Ariane 5.





❖ It is capable to launching missions to low-Earth orbit and deep space.



REPORTS AND INDICES

World's Most Affordable Countries for Immigrants 2024



- ❖ For the fourth year in a row, Vietnam topped the survey's Personal Finance Index in 2024 among 53 destinations.
- ❖ India is among the top 10 most affordable countries for immigrants in 2024 in the Personal Finance Index category.





- ❖ Five other Asian countries are in top 10 include Indonesia (3rd), the Philippines (5th), India (6th), Thailand (8th), and China (10th).
- ❖ The other four countries are situated in Latin America: Colombia (2nd), Panama (4th), Mexico (7th), and Brazil in ninth place.

PERSONALITIES, AWARDS, AND EVENTS

1st International Conference on Steel Slag Road



- ❖ The First International Conference on Steel Slag Road was jointly organized by CSIR-CRRI and PHDCCI at New Delhi.
- ❖ During the event, NITI Aayog released the guidelines for using steel slag in road construction.
- ❖ This technology repurposes steel production waste, creating strong, durable, and eco-friendly roads.
- ❖ Processed steel slag offers high strength, hardness, abrasion resistance, and drainage capacity.
- ❖ It can partially meet India's annual demand for 1.8 billion tonnes of natural aggregates.
- ❖ India's first steel slag road was built in Surat.

IMPORTANT DAYS

National Fish Farmer's Day 2024 - July 10

❖ This day honours and commemorates the contribution of Professor Dr. Hiralal Chaudhury and his colleague Dr. K. H. Alikunhi.





- ❖ It aims to recognize and appreciate the invaluable contributions of fish farmers, aquaculture industry professionals, and other stakeholders toward ensuring a sustainable and thriving fisheries sector.
- ❖ To mark the day this year, the Department of Fisheries is organizing 'Fisheries Summer Meet 2024' in Madurai, Tamil Nadu.



First International Day of Reflection and Commemoration of the 1995 Genocide in Srebrenica 2024 - July 11



- ❖ On May 23, 2024, the UN General Assembly designated this day.
- ❖ The incident was the largest massacre in Europe since the Holocaust during World War Two.
- ❖ In July 1995, the Bosnian Serb army overran Srebrenica and brutally murdered thousands of men and teenagers there, expelling 20,000 people from the town.

World Population Day 2024 - July 11

- ❖ It has been celebrated every year to create the awareness about the growing population of the world.
- ❖ On July 11, 1987, the population of the world reached five billion.





- ❖ The day came to be established by the United Nations and was first observed in the year 1989.
- ❖ This year's theme is "investing in data collection is important to understanding problems, tailoring solutions, and driving progress."
