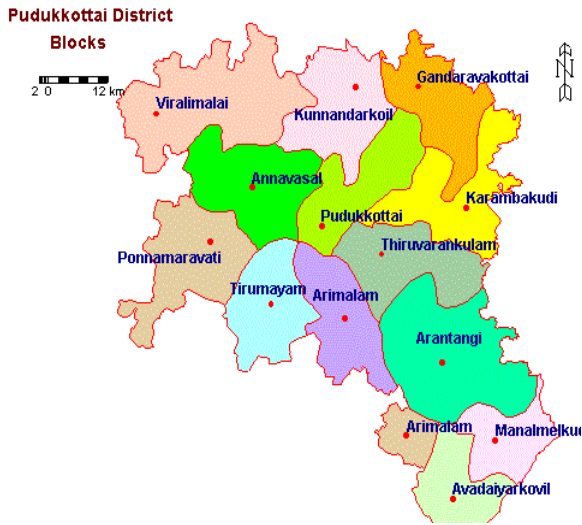




PUDUKKOTTAI
