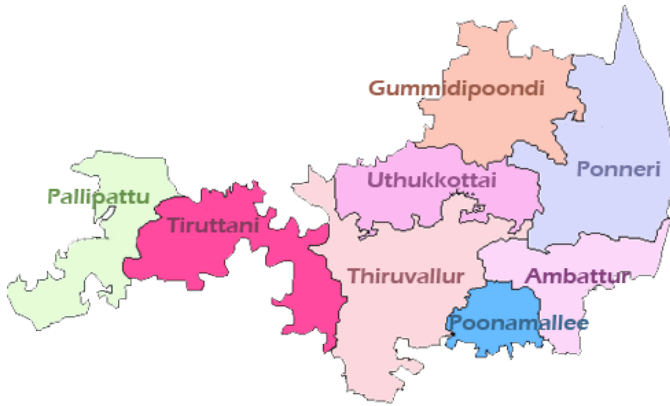

HISTORY:

- ✓ Fastest developing district
- ✓ Located on the Chennai-Tirupathi highway
- ✓ Tiruvallur was originally known as Tiruevullur which specifies the sleeping position of the Holy Lord "Vishnu", in the Veeraragava temple of Tiruvallur.
- ✓ Later people began to refer it by names such as Trivellore and Tiruvallur.

- ✓ Previously, Tiruvallur was a town in the district named Chengalpattu.
- ✓ Ruled by Nawab of Arcot, Golconda rulers, Mughals, British.
- ✓ **River** – Kosasthalaiyar, Adyar, Cooum and Arani river
- ✓ **Forest** – Meagre
- ✓ **Minerals** – Fireclay, Limestone, Quartz, Titanium
- ✓ **crops cultivated** - are fruits crops like mango, banana, aonla, sapota and papaya, vegetables like bhendi, brinjal, gourds, tapioca and yam, spices and condiments like chillies and coriander, flower crops like jasmine, rose, tube rose, marigold and medicinal plants
- ✓ The types of **soil**, predominantly found are red non calcareous and coastal alluvial.
