- ✓ In 1985, the Ramanathapuram district was trifurcated to create the districts of Ramanathapuram, Sivaganga and Virudhunagar district.

POPULAR CITIES:

✓ SRIVILLIPUTHUR:

- Andal Temple West Tower (Gopuram) was recogonized in the State Emblem (adopted on 1949)
- Palcova, divyadesam dedicated to Andal by periyalvar, under the control of Vallabadeva- Pandya, Thirumalai Nayak, Mangammal and pulithevar
- SATHURAGIRI: It is the Abode of God. It is otherwise also called as Mahalingam Hill. This is also called as "Siddargal boomi". 18 Siddhas were said to live here. This is a mysterious hill where it is believed that Siddhars still worship the lord Shiva.
- ✓ Megamalai reserved forest Grizzled Giant Squirrel
- ✓ Sivakasi crackers, Match box and printing industries
- **Rajapalayam:** Winter climates, Ayyanar Temple Falls, Mangoes and dog breeds
