FIRST IN NEWS

- 1. India's first **National Dolphin Research Center (NDRC)** situated on the banks of the **Ganges River** within the **Patna University campus** was officially inaugurated by Bihar Chief Minister Nitish Kumar.
- 2. Union Minister **Shri Rajeev Chandrasekhar** inaugurated **India's first** FutureLABS center at C-DAC Thiruvananthapuram. Named the "Centre for Semiconductor Chips & Systems for Strategic Electronics".
- 3. The Maharishi Ayurveda Hospital in Shalimar Bagh, Delhi, is making headlines for its in-house restaurant, Soma-The Ayurvedic Kitchen, hailed as the first Ayurvedic Kitchen in India.
- 4. France has made history by becoming the **first nation** globally to anchor the **right to abortion** within its constitution.
- 5. Union Minister for Steel and Civil Aviation, **Sh. Jyotiraditya M. Scindia**, virtually inaugurated **India's 1st Green Hydrogen Plant** in Stainless Steel Sector located at Jindal Stainless Limited, **Hisar.**
- 6. India's first small-scale LNG unit was inaugurated at Vijaipur in Madhya Pradesh.
- 7. Researchers have created the **world's first 3D-printed brain** tissue that behaves like a natural brain tissue.
- 8. **ISRO** has achieved a significant milestone with the successful landing of **Pushpak**, **India's first Reusable Launch Vehicle (RLV).**

ECONOMY

- 1. **Moody's**, the global credit rating agency, has raised its **GDP forecast** for India in 2024 to **6.8%**, reflecting a positive economic outlook.
- 2. The Index of Industrial Production (IIP) for January 2024 reflects a growth rate of 3.8%, indicating a slowdown compared to December 2023.
- 3. **S&P Global Ratings** anticipates a repo rate reduction of up to 75 basis points by the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) during the fiscal year 2024-25.
- 4. **All-India Consumer Price Index (CPI)** for Agricultural Laborers and Rural Laborers remained stable, with figures of 1258 and 1269, respectively, based on the 1986-87=100 index.
- 5. **Indian Oil Corporation Ltd (IOC)**, the nation's premier oil firm, is set to revolutionize the motorsports industry by manufacturing fuel tailored for adrenaline-pumping Formula One (F1) racing.
- 6. **The Adami Group** has announced the start of the first phase of the **world's** largest single-location copper manufacturing plant at **Mundra** in **Gujarat**.
- 7. Index provider MSCI raised India's weightage in its **Global Standard** (Emerging Markets) index to a historic high of 18.2%.
- 8. **Gaia AI project** by **Bank for International Settlements** was used to assess **climate-related financial risks** such as analyse company disclosures on carbon emissions, green bond issuance and voluntary net-zero commitments.







9. India's youth accounted for 83% of the country's total unemployed population according to **India Employment Report 2024** has been released by **the International Labour Organisation (ILO)** and the **Institute of Human Development (IHD)**.

- 1. **Buxa Tiger Reserve** have finally got at least one resident tiger after a gap of four decades.
- 2. **World's Tiniest Frog** discovered by scientist in Brazilian forest, 'flea toad' measures just 7.1 millimetres, on average, could be the world's smallest vertebrate.
- 3. Scientists have recently discovered a new species of **70-Million-Year-Old** extinct extinct land snail called **Ferussina**.
- 4. The **Financing Agrochemical Reduction and Management Programme (FARM)** is a \$379 million initiative, a programme is led by **UNEP** to combat agrochemical pollution.
- 5. **COP28 (Troika: Mission 1.5)** President Dr. Sultan Al Jaber has addressed global climate leaders and ministers at the Copenhagen Climate Ministerial.

- 1. **The Department of Biotechnology (DBT)** officially announced the completion of the '10,000 genome' project, a reference database of wholegenome sequences out of India.
- 2. India has conducted the **first human clinical trial** of gene therapy for **'haemophilia A'** at **Christian Medical College Vellore**.
- 3. A US-based nonprofit environmental advocacy group **Environmental Defense Fund (EDF)**
 - Launched **MethaneSAT** a satellite which will track and **measure methane emissions at a global scale**.
- 4. Astronomers has discovered the **smallest known star** to date **TMTS J0526B** which is **seven times the size of Earth**, located approximately **2,760 light years** away from Earth.





- 5. Researchers observed that **RAD51 protein** temporarily binds to the newly synthesized DNA.
- 6. India has conducted the first flight test of the indigenously produced Agni-5 missile as part of its 'Mission Divyastra'.
- 7. Google has partnered with the Election Commission of India (ECI) to provide authoritative information on voting processes for the upcoming general elections.
- 8. **IIT Delhi** announced a collaboration with **Israel Aerospace Industries (IAI)** aiming to promote innovation and technological advancement through joint projects, training initiatives, and research consultancy.
- 9. **The Reserve Bank of India (RBI)** has issued a cautionary message to prevent **Juice jacking**, it is a form of cyberattack where hackers tamper with public USB charging ports.

- 1. Prime Minister Narendra Modi and his Bhutanese counterpart **Tshering Tobgay** jointly inaugurated **The Gyaltsuen Jetsun Pema Wangchuk Mother and Child Hospital** in the Bhutanese capital, **Thimphu**.
- 2. The Indian Consulate in Dubai has introduced a new insurance package called the Life Protection Plan (LPP) for Indian blue-collar workers in the United Arab Emirates (UAE).
- 3. Panama has officially become the 97th member of the International Solar Alliance (ISA).
- 4. **Asif Ali Zardari** took oath as Pakistan's 14th President.
- 5. **Thailand's** lower house of Parliament has passed a groundbreaking bill to **legalize same-sex marriage**.
- 6. **The United States, the United Kingdom**, and **Australia** have forged the **AUKUS** partnership to bolster trilateral security and construct nuclear-powered submarines for **the Royal Australian Navy**
- 7. Rumi Alqahtani, a 27-year-old model and influencer will be the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia's first appearance in the Miss Universe pageant.
- 8. Maryam Nawaz, the daughter of former Prime Minister Nawaz Sharif, became the first-ever woman Chief Minister of a Punjab province in Pakistan.
- 9. **South Korea's fertility rate**, already the **world's lowest**, fell to a record low of 0.72 from 0.78 in 2022 expected to fell **0.68** in 2024.

- 1. India's first indigenous Prototype Fast Breeder Reactor (PFBR) in Kalpakkam, Tamil Nadu, a landmark project fully designed and constructed within the country by Bharatiya Nabhikiya Vidyut Nigam Limited (BHAVINI).
- 2. Prime Minister Narendra Modi inaugurated India's pioneering underwater metro train service in Kolkata, operates in Kolkata Metro's EastWest corridor, is designed to enhance connectivity between Howrah and Salt Lake, the twin cities of West Bengal's capital.
- 3. **Prime Minister Narendra Modi** unveiled a **125-foot bronze statue** of the legendary **Ahom** general, **Lachit Borphukan**, at his burial site in eastern Assam's Jorhat district.
- 4. **Ashwini Vaishnaw**, unveiled **India's fastest** and indigenously developed IP/MPLS (Multiprotocol Label Switching) router in **Bengaluru**.
- 5. Prime Minister Narendra Modi visited **Sabarmati Ashram** to inaugurate **Kochrab Ashram** and launch the Master Plan of the Gandhi Ashram Memorial.
- 6. **GoodEnough Energy** has announced that it will start operations at **India's first** battery energy storage **gigafactory** in the northern region of **Jammu and Kashmir** by October 2023.
- 7. **The Election Commission of India (ECI)- cVIGIL app** allows citizens to report violations of the Model Code of Conduct and election expenditures by capturing photos and videos.
- 8. **Petroleum Minister Hardeep Singh Puri** unveiled **'Ethanol 100'**, an automotive fuel aimed at reducing emissions and promoting sustainability.
- 9. **Union Home Minister Amit Shah** inaugurated the commencement of Piped Natural Gas (PNG) facilities in 41 villages and various development projects in 178 villages under the '**Dilli Gramodaya Abhiyan**'.
